Report: XCR09 Rd 6 - Bundoora Cross Country (Sat July 18)



Blustery but dry conditions welcomed runners to the Victorian Cross Country Championships at Bundoora. There was a full day of running with the school's Victorian XC Championships being held in conjunction with the AV XCR09 series. The schools results for our Geelong athletes may take a little longer to be available as they are not listed under Geelong Region in the results.



The Geelong Region had a small but dedicated open team. The Open Women headed off first over an 8km course. Our regular runners Cathryn Hoare & Eliesha Byrt were our only runners so unfortunately we failed to complete a Div 1 team. Cathryn & Eliesha both ran well, however, and were pleased with their runs in tough conditions.



The Open Men raced over a 12km (4 x 3km) course. The team was significantly bolstered by the last minute inclusion of both Scott Rantall & Jason Woolhouse who were happy to use the race as a tempo session to support the team. Showing their quality, these 2 still managed to be the first Geelong runners home finishing 11th & 15th respectively. Jason seemed to particularly enjoy the run having a good chat to his fellow competitors — though he did note that the responses seemed to deteriorate on laps 3 & 4! Special mention for Ryan Christian (officially the Open Men Deputy Team Manager for the ill informed!) who was competing at Launceston this weekend. In a bid to entice Jason into running, he ventured into the AV head office on Thurs night to grab an entry form & check that they would accept a late entry, before presenting it to Jason on the track just prior to his first rep at Olympic Park!

After falling down the rankings at Coliban, it was pleasing to see the Div 1 team bounce back with a 2nd place this round behind Box Hill that moves us back into the top 3, only 2 points behind Glenhuntly.
